

As we come to safeguarding Sunday it feels right to talk about the release of the Makin Report into the Church's handling of the deeply shocking and disturbing allegations of serious abuse by the late John Smyth.

As a Priest in the Church of England I feel I need to say that I am saddened by the failure of Welby and other senior clergy, to act. Their silence means they enabled John Smyth

not only to act in England, but to move to both Zimbabwe and then South Africa to continue his abuse of boys.

My heart goes out to all who were taken advantage of by those who should have protected them. Instead of protecting them, the institution, yet again, protected their abuser.

I pray that as ++Justin steps down, it goes a little way to bringing Justice to those who were denied the innocence of their childhood by a predator who operated from the cover of an institution that, at every level, did not expose his abuse.

Protecting vulnerable people from harm and speaking up for their rights is an integral part of our scriptural mandate as Christians (Proverbs 31:8).

In our benefice we have pledged to promote an environment and culture where all feel safe and cared for. Our PCC members and all those who work with children have done safeguarding training but the care and protection of children, young people and adults involved in Church activities is the responsibility of **everyone who participates in the life of the church.** If you want to learn more about our Safeguarding Policy please look at the Safer Church posters displayed or talk to myself or our Safeguarding Officer.


