

### **Pause for Thought**

"Grace to help in time of need," is a familiar enough saying isn't it? (It comes from Heb 4 v 16.)

It speaks of God's free gift of help coming from God's kindness, in our time of need. Examples of this grace at work are seen in the miracles recorded for us in the four gospels. Sometimes they show abundant overflowing grace (over 100 gallons of wine at a wedding, food left over after feeding 5,000 people). Most show 'grace at work' just enough to meet a specific need.

We can all recall times, can't we, when we found ourselves in great need or trouble and we prayed (or others prayed for us) and we survived....we're still here....we coped? Grace to help in time of need!

Experience tells us that the same is true of repeated major and minor crises and troubles......and **there** is the abundant, overflowing grace....it **goes on** happening. Doesn't it?

We wake each morning ....a new start....and God is with us. We may wake to face new challenges or problems, or to continue to cope with on-going ones.

We do it with God with us.

Grace to help in time of need.
